Eligibility

To be considered eligible for a HCPTSA scholarship, the applicant must be currently enrolled in a Highline School District High School. Scholarships shall be available for use at any accredited college, university or vocational institute.

Selection Guidelines

Eligible candidates shall be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Volunteer work and/or public service
- Extracurricular activities
- Essay question
- Letter of recommendation
- Grade point average

Deadline

All completed applications must be postmarked by Friday, May 8, 2009. Please mail to Jill Wunch, 654 SW 132nd Street, Seattle, WA 98146. Student selected to receive scholarships will be notified and asked to attend an awards ceremony on Thursday, June 4, 2009.

Funds Distribution

Prior to disbursement of funds, recipients will be required to submit a student enrollment certificate upon entry into their school of higher education. Scholarships must be claimed by December 15, 2009.
